Cétoine takes its cues from its French namesake, a specific breed of iridescent beetle. Considered to be sacred in ancient cultures, the beetle's exoskeleton changes color and form depending on a viewer's perspective.

Inspired by this appealing camouflage, Perini and Kiwibravo took up the challenge of translating it into a design for daily life. Amazingly, they captured the magic of nature in their Cétoine stool.
