

## IGNORED HELENA Michael Roschach

The light installation is based on a lamp by Helena Tyrell that was found and not recognized by the author. Once filled with concrete and destroyed, the result has been forgotten in his workshop. Years later it has been reborn, in a piece that recalls its initial essence, emitting light. Casted in one piece, the form is inspired by a classic shaker wooden table.

## Michael Roschach

Michael Roschach has been researching into the way to dignify concrete since 2008. His fascination for the material and the need to cross the boundaries set for this rough construction material is reflected in his experiments, commissioned art pieces, concrete furniture and objects.
